

Philippe COUBES, MD, PhD is professor of neurosurgery in the department of neurosurgery of the university hospital of Montpellier (France). He has been founding the Unit of Pediatric Neurosurgery and developed functional neurosurgery in this hospital. He is head of the “intractable brain diseases” unit (Unité “Pathologies cérébrales résistantes”).

He achieved, at the beginning of his career, a double training and got licensed for both neurosurgery and neurology.

He is also director of the “Research unit on behavior and movement disorders” – URCMA – IGF - INSERM U 661 – CNRS UMR 5203 Montpellier University.

He has become a specialist in the treatment of movement disorders in children by continuous electrical neuromodulation. His group has extensively reported his experience in this field.
